台灣公共行政與公共事務系所聯合會 (TASPAA)將於 10 月 7、8 日於首爾與韓國公共行政學會(KAPA)簽訂備忘錄。KAPA 來函通知，也將舉行雙方簽約儀式，在這邊特別感謝世新大學行政管理系、暨南大學公共行政學系、淡江大學公共行政學系、東海大學行政管理學系、佛光大學公共事務學系、臺北市立教育大學社會暨公共事務學系等教師和博士生支持與前往。

二、TASPAA 在九月 17 日於臺北市立教育大學，將舉辦本屆理監事第一次會議。

三、TASPAA 尋求 2011 年八月到 2012 年七月承辦會務與年會系所，請有意願的系所與臺北市立教育大學社會暨公共事務學系聯絡。

四、TASPAA 新版網站，部分已經上線，包括各年度的承辦系所的年會議程。目前正設置英文版中。

五、恭喜考試委員、國立政治大學公共行政學 詹中原教授 被選為『國際行政學校暨機構聯合會』(International Association of Schools and Institutes of Administration, IASIA)的理事代表。IASIA 為歷史最悠久也是唯一的全球公共行政與管理的學術組織，其會員來自於個別組織代表(如 NASPAA 等)和個人。

詹委員歷經來自於其他國家競爭與重重壓力，終於替亞洲與台灣爭得一席理事，這次在印尼年會有來自世界各國學者與實務人員(包括中國的國家行政學院在內的 90 多個學者參與)；請密切注意官方網站年會訊息：

貳、臺灣公共行政暨公共事務聯合會(TASPAA)草創訪談

訪問臺灣公共行政暨公共事務聯合會(TASPAA)第一任理事長

TASPAA 特派員跟本會首任理事長國立政治大學顏良恭教授，約定在國立政治大學行政大樓就『臺灣公共行政暨公共事務聯合會』(TASPAA)草創經過進行簡短的聊天。

顏教授首先談到當初(差不多 2002 年)跟國立臺灣大學政治學系彭錦鵬教授在一個場合碰到，彭教授提到公共行政系所規模日趨增加，但學術資源較為不足；因此，建議由政治大學公共行政學系率領公共行政相關系所成立一個學會，將各系所集合在一起。於是在國立政治大學公共行政學系的帶領下第一次籌備會議就召集北部、中部、南部和東部公共行政相關系所參與籌備，第二次則只有北部公共行政相關系所參與籌備，與會成員大多數都贊成成立『臺灣公共行政暨公共事務聯合會』(TASPAA)，於是就展開會議和相關事宜籌辦，適逢 SARS 期間，當初還一度考慮不舉辦，顏教授說當初是以系所為單位，理事設置最大 35 個，但是經過多年公共行政，或公共事務系所在這幾年顯著增加，在中國大陸、韓國皆是如此。顏教授最後問了幾個問題，值得參考：1.TASPAA 運作幾年後有沒有什麼問題?2.跟國外學會平常設置常設性機構，主席或會長才隨著年度更替又有所不同?顏教授也認為在 TASPAA 這個平台上，能夠使公共行政，或公共事務系所對台灣政府治理做深入的貢獻。

11th Public Management Research Association Conference

An online submission system will be available beginning September 1st at www.maxwell.syr.edu/u/pmrc2011.aspx. All of the conference information will be posted at this website including directions for submitting paper and panel proposals. All proposals must be submitted **no later than October 30, 2010**. Review of proposals will commence immediately on November 1, 2010. No notifications of proposal acceptance or denial will be sent by January 15, 2011. If a proposal is accepted, the presenter must register for the conference in order to participate.

We are excited to open the call for proposals for the 11th Research Conference of the Public Management Research Association (PMRA). The conference will be hosted by The Maxwell School of Citizenship and Public Affairs at Syracuse University.

In the multi-disciplinary and multi-method spirit of PMRA and JPART, the program committee for the 11th bi-annual conference welcomes proposals that feature high quality conceptual, qualitative or quantitative research. Empirical proposals will be evaluated based on the significance and quality of the research question, research design, methods, data, findings, and implications for theory and practice. The program committee also welcomes conceptual proposals without qualitative or quantitative empirical components. Conceptual proposals should develop a theory or theoretical framework that provides insight into a compelling research question or subject of study in public management, identify foundational assumptions and key concepts, develop an internally consistent logic or model of causation, and result in specific propositions or testable hypotheses.

es. The program committee welcomes proposals for either empirical or conceptual papers that focus on new areas of research or evaluations of existing streams of research. Proposals from individuals at all stages of their career are welcome.

In addition to individual paper proposals, the program committee encourages the submission of complete panels consisting of no more than four papers. Panel submissions should bring together complementary papers that tackle compelling research questions or subjects of study in public management. Panel proposals should provide information on the overall theme of the panel and indicate how each of the proposed papers connects to the panel's theme. Each of the papers in the panel will be evaluated separately on whether it meets the criteria for individual paper submission. The program committee may drop or add papers to proposed panels.

Finally, a poster session targeted at the work of doctoral students will also be available. Doctoral students can submit their paper proposals for consideration on a conference panel or for the poster session. Only doctoral student papers will be considered for the poster session. If a doctoral student submits their paper to be considered for a conference panel and it is rejected, those papers will also be considered for the poster session. The site hosts and facilities can accommodate approximately 15–20 doctoral student poster sessions. A \$1000 cash prize will be offered to the best poster session and a \$500 for the second place session. An awards committee will be organized and publish separately criteria for the award evaluation. These will be made available to all doctoral students who have a paper accepted for the poster session presentation.

All paper proposals should be no more than 400 words. The conference website will allow authors to separately enter their name(s), institutional affiliation, contact information and email address, and paper title. Each author will be able to submit a 400 word abstract for their research proposal which include the criteria for consideration mentioned above. Submissions missing this information will not be considered for acceptance. Participants will be able to choose to submit a paper, panel, or poster. If submitting a panel, additional space will be provided to include contact information for the panel organizer and for each of the individual panel participants.

A person may submit no more than two proposals (including both single-authored and co-authored papers). Individuals will be limited to two acceptances (at least one of which must be multi-authored) and only one opportunity to present research at the conference.

Public Management Review Symposium on “Performance Practices in Asia-Pacific”

This symposium focuses on performance practices in Asian context. The performance and practices of public agencies are contingent on their internal characteristics and their organizational contexts. East and Southeast Asian contexts affect the internal processes and performance outcomes. For example, many goals and processes have been adopted from the West, however the East and Southeast Asian context pose different challenges, circumstances, and perspectives that sharpen our analysis of the effectiveness of these practices and their impact on performance. Other examples include the duty-based Confucian work cultures and colonial legacies affecting policy and outcomes. Confucian work cultures lead to different processes of decision-making which can lead to lengthy timescales while the colonial legacies in places such as Hong Kong have resulted in very high levels of accountability. This symposium will show how learning from performance in these countries contributes to a more comprehensive conceptualization of organizational performance and strategies for effective government. This symposium is thus relevant to countries beyond this region and thereby advances our knowledge of public management.

The editors welcome proposals that are either empirical or conceptual papers that focus on new areas of research, or evaluations of existing streams of research. The editors welcome proposals on the following topics, and prefer comparative or multi-country analysis:

- Internal characteristics and external context influences on organizational performance;
- The impact and effectiveness of management reform;
- Conceptualization and measurement of performance;
- Duty-based leadership and initiative-taking;
- Cultural elements in team-based performance management;
- Organizational structure and variations in centralized and decentralization;
- Ethics and accountability;
- Impact of colonial legacies;
- Uses of program evaluation and policy analysis in decision-making;
- Pay for performance; and,
- Government and civil society capacity.

Countries to be included in the comparative analysis are likely to include: Japan, South Korea, Mainland China, Taiwan, Thailand, Malaysia, The Philippines, Singapore and Malaysia. This call for proposals extends beyond a traditional call for abstracts and also ask for a willingness to be work with others. It is anticipated the collaborative work will be for the purposes of developing comparative data on topics in countries where survey data can be gathered. In countries where it is difficult to undertake reliable and valid surveys the use of in-depth interviews, secondary data and experiments will be explored.

Single spaced paper proposals of no more than two pages should be sent to Richard Walker (rwalker@hku.hk) by 1st October. Empirical papers should clearly specify research question, research design, methods, data, findings, and implications for theory and practice. For conceptual papers authors should identify foundational assumptions and key concepts, develop an internally consistent logic or model of causation, and result in specific propositions or testable hypotheses. Authors are asked to note their willingness to collaborate in data collection. Authors will be notified of acceptance decisions by 1st December 2010. Data collection and paper writing is scheduled 2011 with a conference to be held in Hong Kong in late spring early summer 2012 following which manuscripts will be sent for full blind peer review. The symposium edition of Public Management Review is anticipated to be published in 2014.
